● Traditional Design Making & Full Work

In traditional design making, physical models or prototypes are often created to test the design's functionality and aesthetics. This step allows designers to see how the design will look and function in real life.

● Civil Structural work

Construction Phase:

Site Preparation: Clearing the construction site and preparing the ground for foundation work.

Foundation Construction: Building the foundation to support the structure, which may involve excavation, reinforcement, and pouring concrete.

Superstructure Construction: Erecting the main structural elements of the building or infrastructure, such as columns, beams, slabs, and walls.

Structural Framing: Assembling and connecting structural components according to design specifications.

Quality Control: Ensuring that construction meets engineering standards and specifications through inspections, testing, and compliance checks.



Traditional qatar Majlish work

Furniture: Traditional majlis furniture includes low-level seating like floor cushions (called 'suffah') or upholstered benches (called 'dikkas').

Textiles: Textiles such as silk or embroidered fabrics are used for cushions, curtains, and wall hangings, adding richness and texture to the space.

Lighting: Soft, ambient lighting is favored, often provided by ornamental lamps, lanterns, or candleholders.



The majlis serves as a symbol of hospitality, generosity, and community in Qatari culture.

It is a place where cultural traditions, storytelling, and discussions on important matters take place.

Traditionally, men and women may have separate majlis spaces or areas within the majlis.

Assessing the economic, environmental, and social feasibility of projects before proceeding to design and construction.

Majlis Interiors Work

- Layout and Space Planning:

Majlis typically have a spacious and open layout, often with low seating arrangements such as floor cushions or upholstered benches.

The seating is arranged in a manner that encourages face-to-face interaction and facilitates hospitality.

- Furniture and Furnishings:

Floor Seating: Cushions (known as 'suffah' or 'mashrabiya') placed directly on the floor or on low wooden platforms.

Coffee Tables: Low-height tables for serving Arabic coffee (qahwa) and dates, often intricately decorated.

Textiles: Richly embroidered cushions, throws, and curtains add texture and color to the space.

Lighting: Soft, ambient lighting from decorative lamps, lanterns, or modern lighting fixtures that complement the traditional decor.



GRC & Wooden Design work

- Interior Design:

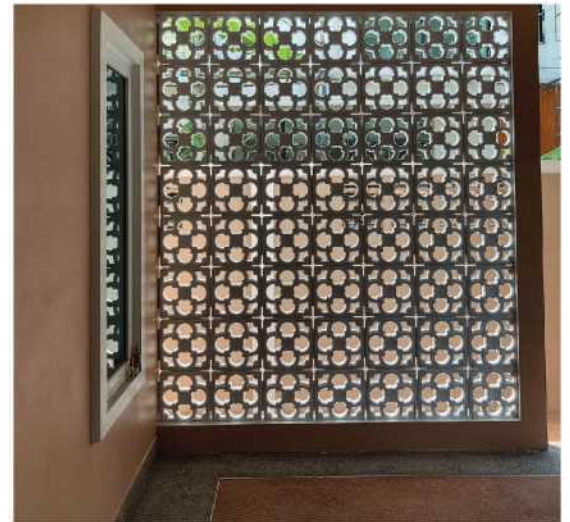
Wooden floors, wall paneling, ceilings, and furniture pieces enhance interior spaces with a warm and inviting atmosphere.

- Design Considerations:

Species and Grain: Different wood species offer unique colors and grain patterns, influencing the aesthetic appeal of the design.

Finish: Wood can be finished with stains, paints, or natural oils to enhance its appearance and protect it from wear and tear.

Sustainability: There is a growing emphasis on using sustainably sourced wood and engineered wood products in design work.



Aluminium Doors & Windows work

- Design Considerations:

Architectural Style: Aluminium doors and windows can be designed to fit various architectural styles, from modern to traditional.

Functionality: Consideration of how doors and windows will function, including sliding, folding, hinged, or tilt-and-turn mechanisms.

Energy Efficiency: Designing for thermal performance by incorporating thermal breaks and double glazing for insulation.



Fabrication Process:

Extrusion: Aluminium profiles are extruded into shapes suitable for frames and sashes.

Cutting and Assembly: Profiles are cut to size and assembled into frames, often using mechanical fastening or welding.

Surface Treatment: Aluminium is treated to improve its appearance and durability, such as anodizing or powder coating for color and corrosion resistance.

Arabian Majlish full work

- Color Scheme and Materials:

Warm and Earthy Tones: Colors reflect the desert landscape, with shades of beige, terracotta, and deep browns.

Natural Materials: Use of wood, natural stone, and textiles like silk, velvet, and embroidered fabrics for cushions and draperies.

- Furniture and Furnishings:

Floor Seating: Cushions (known as 'suffah' or 'mashrabiya') placed directly on the floor or on low wooden platforms.

Coffee Tables: Low-height tables for serving Arabic coffee (qahwa) and dates, often intricately decorated.

Decorative Items: Traditional artifacts such as brass incense burners (mabkhara), decorative lamps, and carpets or rugs with geometric patterns.



Majlis Design & Making works

- Understanding Cultural Context:

Research and understanding of cultural norms, traditions, and preferences related to majlis design.

Consideration of the region's climate, architectural styles, and historical influences.

- Client Consultation and Requirements Gathering:

Discussions with clients to understand their vision, preferences, and functional needs for the majlis.

Establishing the purpose of the majlis (e.g., social gatherings, meetings, family events) and the desired atmosphere (e.g., formal, casual, traditional).



- Materials Selection:

Selection of materials that align with the design concept and functional requirements.

Common materials include wood for furniture and decorative elements, natural stone or ceramic tiles for flooring, and textiles for cushions and draperies.

Roads work

- **Repair and Maintenance:** This includes fixing potholes, cracks, and other surface damage to ensure smooth and safe driving conditions.

Resurfacing: Sometimes entire sections of roads need to be resurfaced to provide a smoother driving surface and extend the life of the road.

Construction: Building new roads or expanding existing ones to accommodate increased traffic or urban development.

- **Infrastructure Improvements:** Installing or upgrading drainage systems, signage, traffic lights, and other infrastructure to improve road safety and efficiency.



Swimming Pool works and Design

- **Design Considerations:**

Size and Shape: Determine the size and shape of the pool based on available space, usage requirements (e.g., lap swimming, recreational), and aesthetic preferences.

Depth: Decide on the depth variations based on intended use (e.g., shallow area for children, deeper area for diving).

Features: Consider additional features such as steps, benches, integrated spas, waterfalls, or fountains.

- **Materials:**

Pool Shell: Common materials include concrete (gunite or shotcrete), fiberglass, or vinyl. Each material has its benefits in terms of durability, cost, and customization.

Decking: Choose materials for the pool deck (e.g., concrete, pavers, wood) that complement the pool design and provide a safe, non-slip surface.



Landscaping works

Car Parking works

Interlock works

- **Herringbone:** A classic pattern that provides strong interlock and is suitable for driveways and high-traffic areas.
- Basket Weave:** Alternating pairs of horizontal and vertical pavers create a woven effect, ideal for patio or walkway designs.
- Circular:** Circular or radial patterns add visual interest and are used for focal points or decorative elements in landscapes.
- Custom Designs:** Pavers can be laid in custom patterns or combinations to create unique designs and enhance curb appeal.



Office Design

Wall Panels and Molding: Gypsum decor includes wall panels adorned with relief patterns and molding that add depth and texture to walls. These panels can be installed as decorative accents or to cover entire walls.



Renovation work
